A 24V electric motor delivers powerful, yet quiet and emission-free performance. Snip is equipped with an integrated self-drive and infinitely variable speed control – a decisive advantage for precise and fatigue-free operation.

A robust, sound-insulated stainless-steel hood reliably protects the machine's components while ensuring quiet operation. The innovative blade holder keeps the cutting blades securely in place even in the event of breakage. Safe to handle and certified by SUVA.

Further details such as the spiked drive wheel that automatically presses the machine against the boards, LED work lights, a mechanical depth gauge, and a support wheel add to the ease of use. Completing the package is a distinctive industrial design that makes Snip not only highly functional but also a visual highlight on any rink.






